HYMNS & READINGS

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone VII — By Thy cross, Thou didst destroy death; to the thief, Thou didst open paradise: for the myrrh-bearers, Thou didst change weeping into joy; and Thou didst command Thy disciples: O Christ God, to proclaim that Thou art risen, granting the world great mercy.

Troparion, Tone I — When Thou, O Lord, wast baptized in the Jordan, the worship of the Trinity was made manifest: for the voice of the Father bare witness to Thee, and called Thee His beloved Son; and the Spirit, in the form of a dove, confirmed the truthfulness of His word. O Christ our God, Who hast revealed Thyself, and hast enlightened the world, glory to Thee.

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone VII — The dominion of death can, no longer, hold men captive: for Christ descended, shattering, and destroying, its powers; hell is bound, while the prophets rejoice, and cry: "The Saviour hath come to them in faith; enter, ye faithful, into the resurrection'.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

Kontakion, Tone IV — Today, Thou hast appeared to the universe; and Thy light, O Lord, hath shone on us, who, with understanding, praise Thee: Thou hast come, and revealed Thyself, O light unapproachable.

PROKEIMENON - Tone VII: The Lord shall give strength to His people. / The Lord shall bless His people with peace. (*Resurrection*)

Offer to the Lord, O you sons of God! Offer young rams to the Lord!

PROKEIMENON - Tone IV: Blessed is He that comes in the Name of the Lord. / God is the Lord and has revealed Himself to us. *(Feast)*

EPISTLE: (*Ephesians 6:10-17*) Brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. ¹¹ Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. ¹² For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual *hosts* of wickedness in the heavenly *places.* ¹³ Therefore take up the whole ar-

mor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. ¹⁴Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

ALLELUIA VERSES: It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to Thy Name, O Most High. • To declare Thy mercy in the morning, and Thy truth by night. • Bring to the Lord, O sons of God, bring to the Lord young rams.

GOSPEL: (*Lake 18:35-43*) *At that time*, as Jesus was coming near Jericho, that a certain blind man sat by the road begging. ³⁶ And hearing a multitude passing by, he asked what it meant. ³⁷ So they told him that Jesus of Nazareth was passing by. ³⁸ And he cried out, saying, "Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!" ³⁹ Then those who went before warned him that he should be quiet; but he cried out all the more, "Son of David, have mercy on me!" ⁴⁰ So Jesus stood still and commanded him to be brought to Him. And when he had come near, He asked him, ⁴¹ saying, "What do you want Me to do for you?" He said, "Lord, that I may receive my sight." ⁴² Then Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has made you well." ⁴³ And immediately he received his sight, and followed Him, glorifying God. And all the people, when they saw *it*, gave praise to God.

IN PLACE OF 'IT IS TRULY MEET' — Magnify, O my soul, the most -pure Virgin Theotokos, more honourable than the heavenly hosts. No tongue knows how to praise thee worthily, O Theotokos; even angels are overcome with awe praising thee; but, since thou art good, accept our faith: for thou knowest our love inspired by God: thou art the defender of Christians; and we magnify thee.

COMMUNION HYMN: Praise the Lord from the heavens, praise Him in the highest! The grace of God has appeared for the salvation of all men. *Alleluia, Alleluia, Alleluia!*
