HYMNS & READINGS

Troparion, Resurrection, Tone I – When the stone had been sealed by the Jews,/ while the soldiers were guarding Thy most pure body,/ Thou didst rise on the third day, O Savior,/ granting life to the world./ The powers of heaven therefore cried to Thee, O Giver of Life:/ “Glory to Thy Resurrection, O Christ!/ Glory to Thy Kingdom!//Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who lovest mankind!”

Troparion, All Saints of America, Tone VIII – As the bountiful harvest of Thy sowing of salvation,/ the lands of North America offer to Thee, O Lord, all the saints who have shone in them./ By their prayers keep the Church and our land in abiding peace//through the Theotokos, O most Merciful One!

Glory to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

Kontakion, All Saints of America, Tone III – Today the choir of Saints who were pleasing to God in the lands of North America/ now stands before us in the Church and invisibly prays to God for us./ With them the Angels glorify Him,/ and all the Saints of the Church of Christ keep festive with them;//and together they all pray for us to the Pre-eternal God.

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen

Kontakion, Resurrection, Tone I – As God, Thou didst rise from the tomb in glory,/ raising the world with Thyself./ Human nature praises Thee as God, for death has vanished./ Adam exults, O Master!/ Eve rejoices, for she is freed from bondage and cries to Thee://“Thou art the Giver of Resurrection to all, O Christ!”

PROKEIMENON (Resurrection) – Tone I: Let Thy mercy, O Lord, be upon us / as we have set our hope on Thee!

V. Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! Praise befits the just!

PROKEIMENON (All Saints of America) – Tone VII: Precious in the sight of the Lord / is the death of His saints.

EPISTLE: *(Romans 2:10-16)* Brethren: glory, honor, and peace to everyone who works what is good, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. ¹¹ For there is no partiality with God. ¹² For as many as have sinned without law will also perish without law, and as many as have sinned in the law will be judged by the law ¹³ (for not the hearers of the law are just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified; ¹⁴ for when Gentiles, who do not have the law, by nature do the things in the law, these, although not having the law, are a law to themselves, ¹⁵ who show the work of the law written in their hearts, their conscience also bearing witness, and between themselves their thoughts accusing or else excusing them) ¹⁶ in the day when God will judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ, according to my gospel.

ALLELUIA VERSES: *God gives vengeance unto me, and subdues people under me. ▪ He magnifies the salvation of the King and deals mercifully with David, His anointed, and his seed forever. ▪ Rejoice in the Lord and be glad, O you righteous!*

GOSPEL: *(Matthew 4:25-5:12)* At that time: a great multitudes followed Jesus from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan. ^{5:1} And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him. ² Then He opened His mouth and taught them, saying: ³ “Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ⁴ Blessed are those who mourn, for they shall be comforted. ⁵ Blessed are the meek, for they shall inherit the earth. ⁶ Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be filled. ⁷ Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy. ⁸ Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God. ⁹ Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God. ¹⁰ Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness’ sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. ¹¹ Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. ¹² Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you.
