TROPARION, RESURRECTION, TONE VI – The Angelic Powers were at Thy tomb;/ the guards became as <u>dead</u> men./ Mary <u>stood</u> by Thy grave,/ seeking Thy most pure <u>body</u>./ Thou didst capture hell not being <u>tempted</u> by it./ Thou didst come to the Virgin, <u>granting</u> life./ O Lord, Who didst <u>rise</u> from the dead,//glory to Thee.

TROPARION, NEW MARTYRS OF RUS, TONE IV – Today the Church of Russia forms a <u>chor</u>us in joy,/ praising her new martyrs and con<u>fes</u>sors;/ hierarchs and priests, royal passion-bearers, right-believing princes and <u>princesses</u>,/ venerable men and women, and all Orthodox <u>Christians</u>./ Having laid down their life for faith in Christ during the days of godless perse<u>cution</u>,/ they preserved the truth by the <u>shedding</u> of blood.//By their protection, O long-suffering Lord, preserve our land in Orthodoxy till the <u>end</u> of the age.

KONTAKION, NEW MARTYRS OF RUS, TONE III – Today the new <u>martyrs</u> of Rus' stand in white robes before the <u>Lamb</u> of God,/ and with the angels they sing to God the hymn of <u>victory</u>:/ "Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and praise, and <u>hon</u>or,/ and power, and <u>strength</u> be to our God//unto the <u>ages</u> of <u>ages</u>. Amen."

Now and ever, and unto ages of ages. Amen.

KONTAKION, RESURRECTION, TONE VI — When Christ God, the <u>Giver</u> of Life,/ raised all of the dead from the valleys of misery with His <u>mighty</u> hand,/ He bestowed resurrection on the <u>human race.</u>//He is the Savior of all, the Resurrection, the Life, and the <u>God</u> of all.

PROKEIMENON, TONE VI – O Lord, save Thy people, / and bless Thine inheritance!

V. To Thee, O Lord, will I call. O my God, be not silent to me!

PROKEIMENON, TONE VII – God is our refuge and strength, / a help in afflictions that severely befall us.

EPISTLE (1 Timothy 1:15-17) – Timothy, my son: This is a faithful saying and worthy of all acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners, of whom I am chief. ¹⁶ However, for this reason I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show all longsuffering, as a pattern to those who are going to believe on Him for everlasting life. ¹⁷ Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever. Amen.

GOSPEL (Matthew 15:21-28) – At that time, Jesus went out from there and departed to the region of Tyre and Sidon. ²² And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, "Have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed." ²³ But He answered her not a word. And His disciples came and urged Him, saying, "Send her away, for she cries out after us." ²⁴ But He answered and said, "I was not sent except to the lost sheep of the house of Israel." ²⁵ Then she came and worshiped Him, saying, "Lord, help me!" ²⁶ But He answered and said, "It is not good to take the children's bread and throw it to the little dogs." ²⁷ And she said, "Yes, Lord, yet even the little dogs eat the crumbs which fall from their masters' table." ²⁸ Then Jesus answered and said to her, "O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire." And her daughter was healed from that very hour.
